6 journals have joined SLJOL between January and June 2009 giving a total of 12 journals. The new journals are:

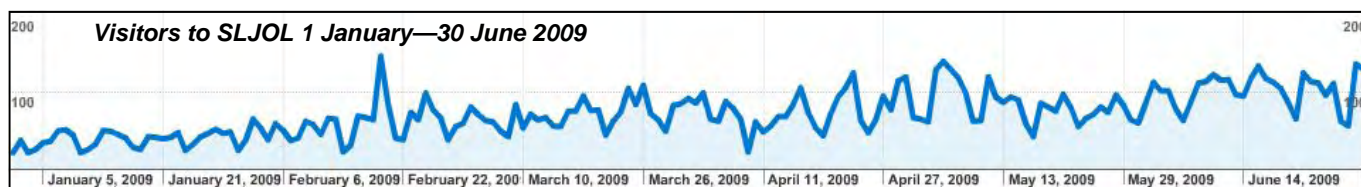

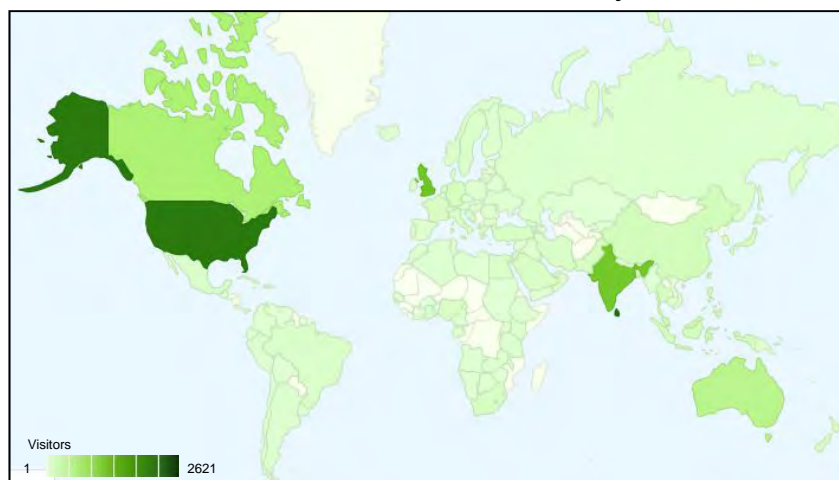
## Visitors to SLJOL

Google Analytics shows that from 1 January—30 June 2009, there were 12,951 visits from 153 countries. The graph below shows that usage has grown during the year, but that is still necessary to promote the site among researchers.

Visitors to SLJOL came from 153 countries: the top three sources for visitors were: Sri Lanka (2,621 from 7 cities), UK (1,374 from 195 cities) and USA (2,487 from 1,059 cities).

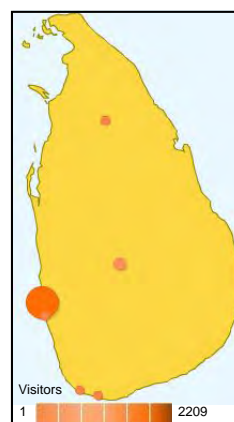


## Global distribution of visitors to SLJOL 1 January—30 June 2009

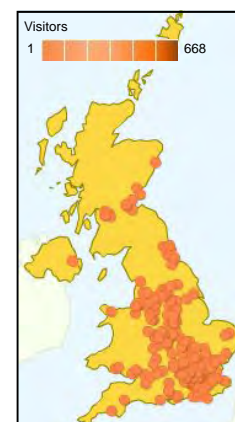

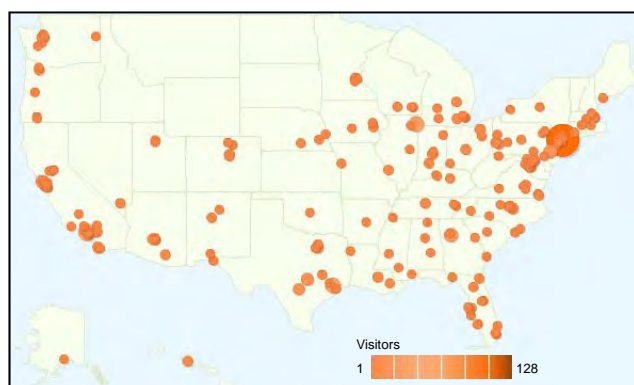
## Location of visitors from Sri Lanka—2,621 from 7 cities



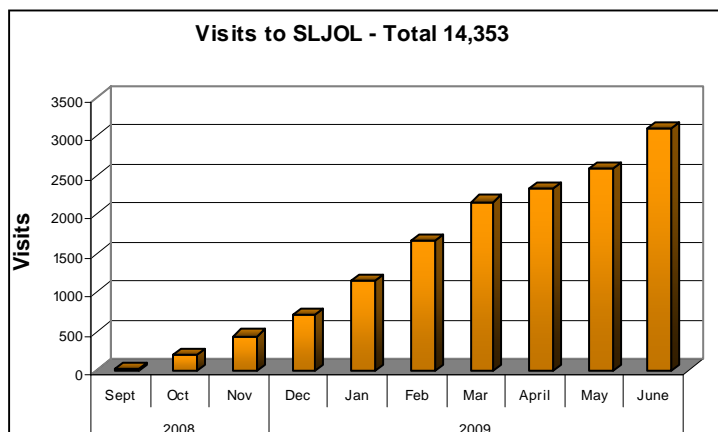
## Location of visitors from the UK—1,374 from 195 cities

## Number of views

At the end of June 2009, there were 55 issues and 487 articles of which 463 were full text. It is still important that all journals load their new issues as soon as they are available. It is also important that more journals are included on the site so that it becomes the definitive location for research from Sri Lanka.

The chart below shows the number of views of full text articles for the SLJOL journals from January to June 2009. 37,650 articles were viewed during this period which is a massive increase on the previous period when only 7,400 articles were viewed. *Sri Lanka Journal of Child Health* still has the highest (14,288) but this is also a large increase over the previous period.

The graph also shows the average number of views per article for each journal and *the Ceylon Journal of Medical Sciences* has the highest with 162. It is also worth noting that although it has only 4 articles, *ICTer* has an average of 55 views per article and it was only loaded onto SLJOL in March.
